- DRA2 is a research-based assessment used to identify students' reading achievement, document progress, and tailor teaching methods to drive effective reading instruction. To maintain reliability and validity, teachers are to use the assessment exactly as it is intended, following all directions in the *Teacher's Guide* and *Blackline Masters*.
- A three week DRA testing window allows teachers to assess 1 or 2 students a day during small group instruction while continuing to meet with most groups. It is a district expectation to continue with small group instruction during any assessment period.
