What is reading fluency?

Not too slow, not too fast, with expression.

What is reading comprehension?

Reading comprehension is the act of understanding what you are reading. It is an intentional, active, and interactive process that occurs before, during and after a person reads a piece of writing.

What is DRA? - Developmental Reading Assessment

A tool used to identify a child's reading level, accuracy, fluency and comprehension.
